United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

David Bell having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with his wife, resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Iron Propeller* vessel called the *Ida M. Stevens* of Buffalo, N. Y. whereof he is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Iron Propeller* vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1869, as appears by the certificate of her last license at the Port of Cleveland, Ohio, dated May 16, 1870, returned to her from surrendered having changed Owners & District. and said License having certified that the said *Iron Propeller* vessel has One deck and no mast, and that her length is 48 feet, her breadth 13 feet, her depth 6 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 18 tons and 09 hundredths, viz:

That she is a *Iron Propeller* has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said David Bell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said *Iron Propeller* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
