In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Michael Mitchell having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ resided at *Buffalo, N.Y.* and that he is a

sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *Buffalo* whereof he is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at *Erie, Pa* in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated August 16, 1840, ~~re-numbered 40,~~ ~~surrendered having changed Owner~~ and said Enrolment having certified that the

said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *87* feet, her breadth *22* feet, her depth *8* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *116* tons and *27* hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a *square* head, and a *square* stern. And the said *Michael Mitchell* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo, N.Y.*
