In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Henrietta Gray having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that she, together with residue at Buffalo, N.Y. and that she is a

citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the B. P. Williams of Buffalo whereof Samuel Hasket is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner of vessel was built at Michigan City, Ind. in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated Jan 21, 1870. Numbered 104. Now surrendered having changed Owner. And said Enrolment, having certified that the

said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 121 feet, her breadth 31 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 292 tons and 31 hundredths, viz:

And the said Henrietta Gray having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
