In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Dwight D. Prouty of ^{Buffalo, N.Y.} having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Wallace Prouty of the same place, are

(each one half part) sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Northern Belle of Buffalo whereof Dwight D. Prouty is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Chaptan, N.Y. in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated April 15, 1867, numbered 38.
