I, Alonso H. Linsen, of Buffalo, N.Y., having taken or subscribed the Oath of having sworn that he, together with the same place, are

(each one half (1/2) part) sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Alaska, of Buffalo, whereof Daniel Boughlan is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1871, as appears by the Certificate of The Shepard Iron Works her builders, on file in this Office.

And Alonso H. Linsen, Surveyor, having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and that her length is 212 feet, her breadth 32 feet, her depth 13 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 1288 tons and 06 hundredths, viz:
