In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864,

James Nelson of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with own five twelfths (5/12) and that Irving Haight of the same place, owns three twelfths (3/12), and that Fanny Shriver of the same place, owns four twelfths (4/12) and that they are

sole owners of the *Sug Propeller* vessel called the *Edmund P. Fish* of Buffalo, N.Y. whereof Eli Shriver is at present Master, and as he has sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Sug Propeller* vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1869, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated April 27, 1870, renumbered 144. Now surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrolment having certified that the

said *Sug Propeller* vessel has One deck and No. mast, and that her length is 41 feet, her breadth 11 feet, her depth 5 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures (9.) Nine and 03 hundredths, viz: tons
