

NORTHERN, NORTHEASTERN, AND NORTHWESTERN FRONTIERS OF THE UNITED STATES.

Official Number 2655. ENROLMENT No. 128. Permanent.

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John S. Koyes of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Edward D. Reed of the same place, are

(each one half (1/2)) sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Buffalo of Buffalo whereof T. A. Palmer is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1851, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 18, 1865, renumbered 24, now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrollment having certified that the

said Propeller or vessel has One deck and one mast, and that her length is 202 feet, her breadth 28 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 829 tons and 90 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said John S. Koyes having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
