I, *W. D. Chy*, having taken or subscribed the Oath that he, ~~together with~~ *sworn*

sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the *Newsboy* of *Buffalo* whereof *L. E. Bloom* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at *Tiaca, N. Y.* in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Jan 7, 1871, numbered 103. Now surrendered having changed Owner. And said Enrollment having certified that the

said Canal Boat or vessel has *One* deck and *No* mast, and that her length is *92* feet, $\frac{7}{10}$ feet, her breadth *17* feet, $\frac{1}{10}$ feet, her depth *7* feet, $\frac{7}{10}$ feet, her height *115* feet, $\frac{1}{10}$ feet, and that she measures *68* hundredths, viz:

King* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
