In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Thomas Barnham of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ own Five Eighths ($\frac{5}{8}$), and that Charles J. Allen of the same place, own Three Eighths ($\frac{3}{8}$), and that they are

sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Aldebaran of Buffalo whereof Leonard J. Ames is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Huron, Mich. in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated June 21, 1859, & numbered 309. Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment.

said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 122 feet, her breadth 28 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 251 tons, and 35 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a scroll head, and a square stern. And the said Thomas Barnham having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
