In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Henry C. Winslow of Buffale, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ is attorney of H. C. Winslow of New York, who owns Seven Eighths (7/8), and that John Coulter of Buffale N.Y. owns One Eighth (1/8), and that they are

sole owners of the Barge or vessel called the L. C. Woodruff of Buffale whereof John Coulter is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Buffale, N.Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated May 2, 1840, renumbered 154. Now surrendered having changed Owner and said Enrolment

said Barge or vessel has one deck and three mast, and that her length is 170 feet, her breadth 22 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 548 tons and 90 hundredths, viz:
