Permanent

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John Helderhouse of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Peter L. Doyle of the same place, are

each one half (1/2) sole owners of the Barge or vessel called the Kellie No. 2107 of Buffalo whereof John Graham is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1840, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at said Port, dated April 22, 1840 & numbered 144. Now surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrolment having certified that the said Barge or vessel has One deck and One mast, and that her length is 162 feet, her breadth 31 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 427 tons and 60 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Barge has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said John Helderhouse having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Barge has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
