In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

James O. Kain of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with own Two Thirds (2/3), and that Thomas Carrigan of the same place, own One third (1/3), and that they are

sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the *Hattie Miller* of Buffalo whereof James O. Kain is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1868, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated November 2, 1869, numbered 97, now surrendered having changed Owner and said Enrolment having certified that the

said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 129 tons and 19 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said James O. Kain, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
