In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

George R. Hand of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ owns Two Thirds (2/3), and that Charles K. Jones of the same place, owns One third (1/3), and that they are

sole owners of the Buffalo Propeller vessel called the Buffalo whereof James H. Hand is at present Master. James H. Hand is a citizen of the United States, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Buffalo vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1862, and rebuilt at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1870, as appears by the Certificate of her last enrolment at this Port, dated April 29, 1870, renumbered 155. said Buffalo Propeller vessel has One deck and No mast, and that having certified that the her length is 65 feet, her breadth 14 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 52 tons and 19 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Buffalo Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said George R.
