In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John Haley of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath  
required by the said Acts and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~  
is a

sole owner of the Low Schooner vessel called the Buffalo whereof Michael Bullerian is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Low Schooner vessel was built at Fairport, Ohio in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated May 21, 1866, numbered 133. Now surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrolment having certified that the said Low Schooner vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 114 feet, her breadth 25 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures (170). One Hundred Seventy tons and 08 hundredths, viz:
