Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath sworn that she, together with

sole owner of the Eng Propeller or vessel called the Edward B. Smith of Buffalo whereof Michael Barr is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Eng Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1869, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated May 20, 1870, renumbered 184, now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment having certified that the said Eng Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 39.7 feet, her breadth 7.3 feet, her depth 4 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures Ten (10) tons and 66 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Eng Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Honora Barr having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Eng Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
