In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Adam Hartman of Grand Island, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with it or

sole owner of the Lug Propeller vessel called the Addie of Buffalo whereof John Klepser is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Lug Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated June 14, 1869 & numbered 294. Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment having certified that the

said Lug Propeller vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 24 feet, her breadth 10 feet, her depth 4 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures Seven (7) tons and 33 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Lug Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Adam Hartman having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Lug Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
