In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John Ganson of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ is a

sole owner of the Barge or vessel called the Erastus Corning of Buffalo whereof Geo. H. Clarke is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Tonawanda, N.Y. in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated August 1, 1840, numbered 20. Now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrolment.

said Barge or vessel has One deck and three masts, and that her length is 204 feet, her breadth 35 feet, her depth 14 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 832 tons and 43 hundredths, viz:

And the said John Ganson, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Barge Erastus Corning has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
