In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John Green of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with one half (1/2) and that Charles H. Jones, and George R. Bond of the same place, each own one fourth (1/4), and that they are

citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Sloop Propeller vessel called the O. L. King of Buffalo whereof Joseph Wolfe is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1867 (as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrolment at this Port, dated March 26, 1870, numbered 120. Now surrendered having changed owners. And said Enrolment, having certified that the

said Sloop Propeller vessel has One deck and one mast, and that her length is 63 feet, her breadth 15 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 41 tons and 21 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Sloop Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said John Green, having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
