In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Samuel V. Parsons of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together~~ with one John Humble of the same place, own One fourth (1/4), and are

citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Orient of Buffalo, whereof M. M. Holland is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Tonawanda, N. Y. in the year 1840, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrolment at the Port of Chicago, Ill. dated June 5, 1841, numbered 204, N.Y. surrendered, vessel having arrived at her Home Port, and said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that

her length is 138 feet, 6/10
 her breadth 26 feet, 3/10
 her depth 11 feet, 4/10
 her height 10 feet, 10/10
 and that she measures 319 tons
 and 46 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said Samuel V. Parsons having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
