of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Western, and Southern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the 17th June, 1864.

Erastus Corning of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the oath that he, together with

sole owner of the Barge or vessel called the Erastus Corning of Buffalo whereof Geo. H. Clarke is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Tonawanda, N.Y. in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at that Port, dated May 27, 1871, numbered 186, now surrendered having changed Owner And said Enrolment

said Barge or vessel has One deck and three masts, and that her length is 204 feet, her breadth 35 feet, her depth 14 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 832 tons and 43 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Barge has a figure head, and a square stern. And the said Augustus L. Taylor having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Barge has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
