In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Augustus C. Taylor of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with it a

sole owner of the Barge or vessel called the *Erastus Corning* of Buffalo whereof *Geo. H. Clarke* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at *Tonawanda, N. Y.* in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at *Buff Port*, dated *May 27, 1871*, numbered *186*, now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrolment

said Barge or vessel has *One* deck and *three* masts, and that her length is *204* feet, her breadth *35* feet, her depth *14* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *822* tons and *42* hundredths, viz:

That she is a Barge has a figure head, and a square stern. And the said *Augustus C. Taylor* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Barge has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo, N. Y.*
