I, J. Fraser of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath sworn that she, ~~together with~~

sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the St. Andrew of Buffalo whereof J. Fraser is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Wilan, Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Erie, Pa. dated April 27, 1869 & numbered 29 Now surrendered having changed Owners & District. I, the said Enrolment, having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 144 feet, her breadth 30 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 322 tons and 86 hundredths, viz:
