In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

George Talbot of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with William Richardson of the same place, are

(each one half 1/2) sole owners of the Sloop Propeller or vessel called the Isaac Newton of Buffalo whereof William Richardson is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at the Port of Toledo, Ohio, dated April 10, 1864, numbered 48, now surrendered having changed Owner & District. said Enrolment having certified that the

said Sloop Propeller vessel has One deck and No. mast, and that her length is 54 feet, her breadth 12 feet, her depth 6 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 21 tons and 72 hundredths, viz:

And the said George Talbot having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
