In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Thomas Greenwood of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with own two thirds (2/3) and that Henry G. Payne of the same place own One Third (1/3), and that they are

citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Steam Tugboat vessel called the Jake Miller of Buffalo whereof James Meredith is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Steam Tugboat vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1841, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated July 18. 1841, numbered 10, now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment

said Steam Tugboat vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 50 feet, her breadth 10 feet, her depth 4 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 24 tons and 47 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Steam Tugboat has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Thomas Greenwood having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Steam Tugboat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
