of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Geo. H. Perkins of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath. required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with it a

sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Geo. H. Kilmat of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Havana, N. Y. in the year 1865, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Rochester, N. Y. dated June 17, 1870. Numbered 533. Now surrendered having changed District.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 17 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 116 tons and 10 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Geo. H. Perkins having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
