In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

D. E. Bailey of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with

sole owner of the Bernal Boat or vessel called the Little Giant of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Bernal Boat vessel was built at Pine Valley, N.Y. in the year 1865, as appears by her last Enrolment at this Port, dated Oct 23, 1869 & numbered 92. The Certificate of which has been left as appears by the affidavit of D. E. Bailey, on file in this Office, and said Enrolment having certified that the said Bernal Boat vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 79 ft. 10 in. her breadth 10 ft. her depth 4 ft. her height 10 ft. and that she measures 43 tons and 80 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Bernal Boat has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said D. E. Bailey having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Bernal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
