In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

A. A. Root of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with his Secretary of the Western Transportation Company of Longwood, N.Y. and that the said Company are

citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Vanderbilt of Buffalo whereof H. D. Peatt is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Port Huron, Mich. in the year 1841, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrolment at the Port of Port Huron, Mich. Dated Oct 17, 1841, Numbered 2, now surrendered, vessel having arrived at her Home Port, having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has

two decks and one mast, and that her length is 223 feet, her breadth 34 feet, her depth 14 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 1202 tons and 85 hundredths, viz:

Root having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
