In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Sarah E. Kind of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that she, together with O. L. Kind of the same place, are

(each one half 1/2) sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Annie Sherwood of Buffalo whereof O. L. Kind is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Fairport, Ohio in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated Oct 12 1869 & numbered 84. Now surrendered having changed owners And said Enrolment.

said Schooner or vessel has One deck and three masts, and that her length is 184 feet, her breadth 32 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 622 tons and 44 hundredths, viz:
