of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Southern, and Western Waters of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the 2d March, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

*Bartholomew M. Babe* having taken or subscribed the Oath of Allegiance, and sworn that he, together with *James M. Babe* of the same place, each own  $\frac{1}{8}$ th (19/48), and that *James M. Babe*, own  $\frac{1}{8}$ th (19/48), and that they are

sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the *Imperial* of Buffalo whereof *Bartholomew M. Babe* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated April 16, 1870 & numbered 134. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 135 feet, her breadth 30 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 299 tons, and 39 hundredths, viz:

Babe*, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner *Imperial* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
