In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Charles Beatty of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ it a

sole owner of the Sloop Propeller vessel called the C. H. Jones of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated Aug 9. 1871. numbered 25. Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment

said Sloop Propeller vessel has One deck and Sq. mast, and that her length is 58. 7/10 feet, her breadth 15. 1/10 feet, her depth 8. 1/10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures Twenty seven (27) tons and 24 hundredths, viz:
