In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

John Mahoney of Buffalo, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with James Mahoney, and Simon Kash of the same place are

each one third (1/3) citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Ottawa of Buffalo whereof Michael T. Lynch is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Belleville, C. H. in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at the Port of Erie, Pa. dated June 22, 1856, &c. numbered 18. Now surrendered having changed Owners Districts And said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 107 feet, her breadth 24 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 157 tons and 62 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said John Mahoney having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
