In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Henry C. Kinslow of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath, required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Wm. H. Kinslow of the same place, are

(each one half 1/2) sole owners of the Barge or vessel called the Favorite of Buffalo whereof Henry C. Kinslow is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Newport, Mich. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 14, 1870, Numbered 129. Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrollment, having certified that the

said Barge or vessel has One deck and Three masts, and that her length is 166 feet, 2/10 her breadth 31 feet, 2/10 her depth 12 feet, 8/10 her height 10 feet, 10/10 and that she measures 451 tons and 70 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Barge has a female head, and a square stern. And the said Henry C. Kinslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Barge has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
