

Official Number **ENROLMENT No. 100.** Permanent

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Henry C. Kinslow of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken & subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with his attorney of New York, who owns three fourths (3/4), and that Wm. G. Kinslow of Buffalo, N.Y. owns one fourth (1/4), and that they are

sole owners of the Bark or vessel called the L. C. Woodruff of Buffalo whereof Henry C. Kinslow is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Bark or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1806, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated April 12, 1841 numbered 136 now surrendered having changed Owners said Enrolment.

having certified that the said Bark or vessel has One deck and three masts, and that her length is 170 feet, her breadth 33 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 578 tons and 90 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Bark has a raked head, and a square stern. And the said Henry C. Kinslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Bark has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
