In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Robert Montgomery of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with

owns One half (1/2) and that Charles Hamilton of the same place, owns One fourth (1/4) and that Charles J. Magill of Chicago, Ill. owns One fourth (1/4), and that they are

citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the James R. Bentley of Buffalo whereof Charles Hamilton is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Fairport, Ohio in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 17, 1872, numbered 111. Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrollment

said Schooner or vessel has One deck and three masts, and that her length is 187 feet, her breadth 34 feet, her depth 13 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 574 tons and 58 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a figure head, and a square stern. And the said Robert Montgomery having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
