In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Stephen F. Sherman of Buffalo, N.Y. Having taken or subscribed the Oath
 required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with
 John P. Frisbe of the same place, are

(each one half 1/2) sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Emma Petrie of Buffalo whereof Stephen F. Sherman is at present Master. citizens of the United States, and
 and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States,
 and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Rochester, N.Y.
 in the year 1871, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated April 11, 1872 numbered 101, now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment

said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that
 her length is 96 feet,
 her breadth 17 1/10 feet,
 her depth 7 1/10 feet,
 her height 2 1/10 feet,
 and that she measures 149 tons
 and 93 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said Stephen F. Sherman having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
