In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Edwin I. Evans of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with James C. Evans under the firm of J. C. & E. I. Evans own Fifty four Seventyeths (54/70) and that Wm. Wells of the same place own Nine Seventyeths (9/70) and that Albert Briggs of the same place own Seven Seventyeths (7/70), and that they are

sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Buffalo, whereof Albert Briggs is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller of vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated April 16. 1867, numbered 43. Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment having certified that the

said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and that her length is 194 feet, 6/10 feet, her breadth 29 feet, 1/10 feet, her depth 13 feet, 8/10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 861 tons and 18 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Edwin I. Evans having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
