In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Samuel L. Watson of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ own three fourths (3/4) and that Samuel D. Kelderhouse of the same place, own One fourth (1/4), and that they are

sole owners of the Brig or vessel called the Helfenstein of Buffalo whereof Louis Bogert is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or vessel was built at Milwaukee Wis. in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated Sept 13, 1840, numbered 70. Now surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrolment

said Brig or vessel has One deck and two mast, and that her length is 130 feet, her breadth 26 feet, her depth 13 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 281 tons and 40 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Brig Samuel L. Watson has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said Samuel L. Watson having agreed to the description and admasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
