In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

D. S. Jones of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oaths required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with his son owns Three Eighths (3/8) and that D. S. Danforth of the same place owns Four Eighths (4/8) and that Edwin Woodruff of Chyria Ohio owns One Eighth (1/8). and of said Schooner and that they are

citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the D. S. Danforth of Buffalo whereof H. C. Headenuff is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Tonawanda N.Y. in the year 1872, as appears by the Certificate of D. S. Jones Shipwright her builder on file in this Office

And Alongo H. Jensen Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and Three masts, and that her length is 193 feet, her breadth 33 feet, her depth 14 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 715 tons and 104 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a Dragon head, and a square stern. And the said D. S. Jones having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo N.Y.
