of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Robert Kheban of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~is~~ ^{is} ~~is~~ ^{is} it a

sole owner of the Sloop Propeller vessel called the Buffalo whereof Thomas Thompson is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1842, as appears by the Certificate of G. H. Katter, shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.

Alonzo H. Loring, Surveyor, having certified that the said Sloop Propeller vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is 39.11.5 feet, her breadth 10 feet, her depth 2 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 10 tons and 73 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Sloop Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said Robert Kheban having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
