Act of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships in Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Buffalo, N.Y. giving taken or subscribed the Oath sworn that he, together with

sole owner of the *Sloop Propeller* vessel called the *Charles E. McDonald* of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Sloop Propeller* vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1872, as appears by the Certificate of *Harvel Brothers*, Shipwrights her builders. On file in this Office.

And *Alonzo H. Serwin* having certified that the said *Sloop Propeller* vessel has One deck and one mast, and that her length is 47.12 feet, her breadth 12.5 feet, her depth 5.10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 16 tons and 15 hundredths, viz:

That she is a *Sloop Propeller* has a *plain* head, and a *round* stern. And the said *Henry Skollon* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said *Sloop Propeller* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
