In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

is Attorney of N. C. Winslow of New York, who owns Thirteen Twentieths (13/20) and that Mary Winslow of N.Y. owns Five Twentieths (5/20) and that John Coulter of Chicago Ills owns Two Twentieths (2/20) and that they are

sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the "Caunden" of Buffalo whereof John Coulter is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States,

and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Cleveland, State of Ohio in the year 1872, as appears by the Certificate of her temporary Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland Ohio. Numbered 2, & dated April 24, 1872. Now surrendered, vessel having arrived at her Home Port

Said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and Three masts, and that her length is 191 feet, her breadth 33 feet, her depth 14 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 694 tons and 17 hundredths, viz:
