sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the *John Stillwagner* of *Buffalo* whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at *Ponawanda, N.Y.* in the year 1842, as appears by the Certificate of *Christof Schurwinger* shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.

And *Alonso H. Loomis, Surveyor* having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *95* feet, her breadth *14* feet, her depth *8* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *120* tons and *45* hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has no head, and a square stern. And the said *Christof Schurwinger* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo, N.Y.*
