Buffalo having taken or subscribed the Oath that he, together with John T. Heath of the same place,

(each one third 1/3) sole owners of the Sug Propeller or vessel called the Mohawk of Buffalo whereof Oliver Greene is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sug Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1842, as appears by the Certificate of Geo. H. Kottler. Shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.

And George W. Scriven. Surveyor. said Sug Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 29.11.5. 8 feet, her breadth 6 feet, her depth 2 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures Ten (10) tons and 81, hundredths, viz:

That she is a Sug Propeller has a plain head, and a round stern. And the said John Durr having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Sug Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo. N.Y.
