Christof Schwinger of Donawanda, having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn it is a

sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the John Stillwager of Buffalo, whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Donawanda, N.Y. in the year 1842, as appears by the Certificate of Christof Schwinger shipwright her builder, on file in this Office.

And Alonzo H. Loomis, Surveyor, having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth is 14 feet, her depth is 8 feet, her height is 10 feet, and that she measures 120 tons, and 45 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Canal Boat has no head, and a square stern. And the said Christof Schwinger having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
