In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Charles Ensign of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath that he, together with it a

sole owner of the Propeller or vessel called the Cuba of Buffalo whereof Nicholas Gebhard is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1842, as appears by the Certificate of Wm. J. King Jr shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.

Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two deck and one mast, and that her length is 231 feet, her breadth 35 feet, her depth 13 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 1526 tons and 01 hundredths, viz:
