In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

N. C. Kinslow of New York having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, ~~together with~~ owns $\frac{3}{4}$, and that *Mary Ann Kinslow* of the same place, owns $\frac{1}{8}$, and that *Bennet C. Kinslow of Buffalo, N.Y.* owns $\frac{1}{8}$ and that they are

sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *William Grandy* of *Buffalo* whereof *N. C. Kinslow* is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio* in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at *Phil Post*, dated *October 14, 1867*, numbered *217*, now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrolment.

said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *Three* masts, and that having certified that the her length is *165* feet, her breadth *32* feet, her depth *11* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *464* tons and *97* hundredths, viz:

That she is a Schooner has a figure head, and a square stern. And the said *N. C. Kinslow* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo, N.Y.*
