In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Charles Ensign of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with Geo. H. Holt of Westfield, Chautauqua Co., N.Y. and each own Seven Sixteenths (7/16), and that J. W. Brett of Cleveland, Ohio owns Two Sixteenths (2/16) and that they are

sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Colorado of Buffalo, whereof D. I. Palmer is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrolment at this Port, dated May 21, 1867, and numbered 121. Now surrendered having changed Owner. And said Enrolment

said Propeller or vessel has two decks and No. mast, and that her length is 254 feet, her breadth 35 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 1470 tons and 55 hundredths, viz:
