sole owner of the Barge or vessel called the Venice Buffalo whereof L. H. Gage is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Rochester, N.Y. in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 15, 1868, numbered 358, now surrendered, having changed Owner, & vessel altered to a Barge from a Schooner. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barge or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 116 feet, her breadth 25 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 217 tons and by hundredths, viz:

That she is a Barge has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said Nelson Holland having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Barge has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
