In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels," &c., passed the 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Edwin P. Evans of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with James B. Evans under the firm name of J. & E. P. Evans own Six Sevenths (6/7) and that Mrs Wells of the same place owns One seventh (1/7) of said Propeller. and that they are

sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Buffalo whereof E. P. Evans is at present Master. and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrolment at this Port dated April 16. 1867. Number 41. Now Surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrolment having certified that the

said Propeller or vessel has Two decks and One mast, and that her length is 183 feet, her breadth 27 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 76 tons and 87 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Propeller has a plain head, and a Square stern. And the said Edwin P.
