

ENROLLMENT No. 190. Permanent.

States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, ted States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, 6th May, 1864, and 17th June, 1864.

Robert A. Jones of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath, required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he, together with own One half (1/2), and that Geo. H. Van Etten and Harvey Hall of Bay City, Mich. each own One fourth (1/4), and that they are

sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Buffalo and as he hath sworn that he is at present Master, and that the said Propeller of vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1835, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated June 10, 1872 and numbered 189 and surrendered having changed owners And said Enrollment having certified that the

said Propeller or vessel has two deck and one mast, and that her length is 182 feet, her breadth 27 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 676 tons and 87 hundredths, viz:

That she is a Propeller has a plain head, and a square stern. And the said Robert A. Jones having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given, in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.Y.
